DoI and unique identifiers



■ **Issue:** identifiers should be uniquely linked to the content; therefore, we should avoid to create a Zenodo DOI if an identifier already exists, e.g. doi, ISBN, ISSN, etc.

Proposals:

- use 'Information on' + existing title and give a brief description of the record/report and insert the existing identifier under 'related identifier' together with its relation to the record, e.g.: compiles/creates this record, is the source this upload is derived from, is identical to this upload, is an alternate identifier to this upload.
 - you may also wish to include a note/paragraph at the top of the record 'description' indicating the link/location of the original source, e.g. 'this is a [summary of the] Report [...] ISBN: XXX-X-X-XXXXX-XX-X) / weblink'. – see an example at: https://doi.org/10.5281/zenodo.5483124
- register your organisation ISBN as an actionable ISBN ISBN-A see more info at: https://www.doi.org/factsheets/ISBN-A.html

License and copyright: Kj community policy



- Open Access rights are recommended
- Creative Commons Attribution license types to be used
- Curation policy: `Each submission [...] has a license specifying the conditions of use. In this way the reuse of any object deposited can be tracked by the provider.'
- Items subject to copy right restrictions should only be shared if these rights are not infringed by publishing on an open platform.
- All persons reproducing, redistributing, exploiting or making commercial use of digital objects published in the community are expected to adhere to the terms and conditions described by the license assigned to each published object. EFSA is not responsible for any misuse of the documents and files.
- **☒** Specific license referring to copyright and terms of use applying to the files of a record <u>may be created by the uploader</u> to suit specific needs. Such license should be sent to Zenodo helpdesk for inclusion the licenses list on Zenodo.
