- FP operational framework lack of clarity in connecting current and new frameworks, proposed work for 2022, and links to TR requirements and EFSA Strategy 2027
- Working Packages lack of understanding on process for identification of main areas for action + possible overlap with current FP activities
- Inclusiveness on the analysis of review outcomes and formulation of actions for 2022
- Time constrains for processing recent information shared (review report, ToR) & time for decision-making at MS level

Setting of an AF Steering Group on FP Review



Mandate: prepare the new FP operational framework

Composition: volunteer AF & FP representatives + EFSA representatives

Governance: Co-chairing EFSA + 1 MS (logistics by EFSA)

Time availability needed: from Steering Group members for meetings, work in between meetings, looking into working material

Reporting: AF and FP plenaries in 2022 + written procedure as needed

Working material: review report, scoping document (WPs), MS experiences on current framework, analysis of ongoing work (e.g. AF DG on DATA & Partnerships, CEN), financial & resource solutions for strengthened FP support

Deliverables: ToR (Q1), Progress Report (Q2), Draft Operational Framework (Q3), draft FP Agreements for 2023 (Q4)
