Legislation on coatings

No EU-harmonised material

National rules apply, or article 3 of Regulation no 1935/2004

However:

- > Each MS differs:
 - General rules and restrictions for all materials
 - Categorization of 'types of coating'
 - Rules and restrictions applicable for each type of coating, or type of substrate
- > Not all are translated in English, or CAS nrs available
- > Principle of mutual recognition applies

Enforcement is almost impossible



Set scope of TG

Definition of coatings

- are impregnating agents (waxes, PFAS,...) included?
- a) Set specific guidance for all types?
- b) Restrict to only the main types?
 - If so, which ones?
 - Set general guidance for `coatings' out of scope?



Existing categorizations of coatings

CoE Resolution / BE Royal Degree

- Coatings for metal packaging
- Flexible packaging coatings
- Heavy-duty coatings / High performance varnishes

NL Warenwet regeling (future)

- General purpose coatings
- Coatings for specified applications:
 - Wax coatings (solvent free)
 - \circ Metallic coatings
 - Temperature resistant coatings

NL Warenwet regeling (current) :

- > Dispersions of macromol. substances:
 - in water
 - in organic liquids
- > Dispersions of paraffins & waxes in water
- Solutions: in water
 - in organic solvents
- Solvent-free: waxes & waxy products
 - other solvent-free materials
- Metallic coatings
- PTFE coatings for cooking and baking
- Coatings on Paper & Board
- Coatings on metals
- Impregnation of wood & cork



Agree on categorization

By type of coating?

- organic (polymeric / non-polymeric) / inorganic, ...

By type of substrate?

For paper and board / metals / organics / textiles / wood & cork / ceramics

By type of use of purpose?

- General purpuse / Heat resistant / impregnation
- Single use / repeated use (packaging / utensils)?

Combination of the above?
