

## Survey on new biotechnologies in microorganisms

## Note on the processing of personal data in the context of this survey:

Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data, is applicable to the present survey. - This survey is organized by means of the European Commission's official survey management tool 'EUSurvey'. The reference installation of the tool is hosted at DG DIGIT of the European Commission and your survey contribution is stored in the datacentre of DG DIGIT.
- The NIF Unit of EFSA is the data controller in charge of organising the survey. After the closure of the survey, a staff member in charge downloads in a secure manner the data file with the survey replies and transfers it to a confidential folder of EFSA's Document Management System with restricted access. The survey answers collected in this way are kept as long as needed for the purpose of the survey analysis and the data will not be used for any other purpose. After the analysis has been completed, survey answers will be destroyed.
