Key messages

- CLE sees the platform developing positively with improvements being made
 - Simplified ToC for GMOs applications.
- Opportunities for improvement to increase efficiency of the platform still exist
- Opportunities for exchange and continuous dialogue are very much appreciated

ESFC Platform



- Limitation of the platform to handle only one set of questions at a time
 - The system does not allow several requests for information to run in parallel
 - A workaround for this limitation is communication by e-mail, i.e. EFSA anticipating ADR (letter + annex) by e-mail
 - Submission of voluntary information by the applicant requires previous communication by e-mail requesting to unlock relevant sections
 - To increase efficiency and decrease complexity, the platform should allow for handling several ADR in parallel
- Some applicants have experienced issues when downloading an application via the "Download all files.zip" button
 - Downloading taking too long, a message appears indicating a link is being sent to download the application, but the link is not received or is received the day after.
 - Downloading taking too long, a message appears indicating a link is being sent to download the application. The link is received. However, in some cases the link is not correct, *i.e.* it allows requester to download an application that is not the relevant one.
