EVALUATION REPORT OF EFSA NETWORKS

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EFSA NETWORKS - BACKGROUND

EFSA promotes the networking of scientific organisations of EU Member States

RAL unit coordinates 14 networks and 8 sub-groups

EFSA Management Board decision (2021):

- EFSA shall evaluate the work of each Network at least every three years, beginning in 2021
- EFSA shall **report the outcome** of such evaluations of networks to the **Advisory Forum** and **Management Board**
- Advisory Forum non-binding recommendation
 on either the continuation or discontinuation of each
 network; the Management Board shall then decide






EFSA NETWORKS – EVALUATION OUTSOURCED



• EFSA shall evaluate the work of each Network at least every three years, beginning in 2021



EFSA outsourced the evaluation, developed Terms of Reference (ToRs), asking the analysis of each individual network and sub-group during the period 2021-2023 to evaluate:

- Effectiveness
- Efficiency
- Sustainability
- Adequacy (relevance)
- Impact



EFSA NETWORKS - EVALUATION METHODOLOGY



The evaluation addressed **five evaluation questions**, applying 22 judgement criteria.

The findings are based on

- online survey (426 valid answers = 30%)
- interviews EFSA network coordinators (22)
- desk research and documentation





Question 1: Has each network/sub-group enhanced the work of EFSA? YES



- o valuable inputs
- o **useful support** to EFSA
- o common activities:

exchange of data/information

exchange of risk assessment

methodology (including method, guidelines

and sometimes simulation exercises)

collaboration in data collection.



Question 2:

Has each network/sub-group enhanced collaboration between EFSA and the Member States in the risk assessment activities? *YES*



- o enhanced collaboration
- o more effective risk assessment activities
- o common activities:

exchange data/information exchange expertise/best practice data collection

- variable engagement
- o unique and irreplaceable





Question 3: overarching MB objective? YES


- o in line with MB objectives set in Art.2
- diversity of networks/sub-groups

Question 4: individual targets from ToR? YES



- objectives fulfilled
- o some network's ToR are not always relevant to sub-group
- top accomplishments: networking, sharing information and data, knowledge, experience/best practices, upcoming EFSA activities and addressing specific questions

Question 5: Is the topic of each network/sub-group of current interest and/or efficient in addressing it? YES



- o **relevant** to health/safety risks and scientific developments
- respond promptly to emerging health/safety challenges and crises
- EFSA budget on networks is sustainable
- network participants' and network coordinators' time
 is sustainable (next 3-5 years)





EFSA NETWORKS – CONCLUSIONS 1/2



EFSA managed 14 networks and 8 sub-groups during the period 2021-2023

- overall found positive outcomes
- all individual networks and sub-groups have confirmed positive on 5
 evaluation criteria
- unique opportunities to collaborate, network, share information and data among MSs/EFSA on a specific subject, share risk assessment methodologies, react promptly to urgent health & safety issues
- unique and irreplaceable role in fostering collaboration between MSs towards common goals



EFSA NETWORKS – CONCLUSIONS 2/2

Areas of improvements



- EFSA networks/sub-groups are very diverse and target different activities
- clarify the criteria and process for establishing networks/subgroups (time/length/scope)
- improve the process and criteria of experts' nominations
- explore ways to improve the support of Network representatives at MS level
- optimise the technological tools
- enhance the knowledge sharing and best practice sharing
- explore the opportunities of further collaboration
