## **CLARIFICATION N°5**

Call reference: GP/EFSA/MESE/2022/01

Call title: NAMS4NANO: Integration of New Approach Methodologies results in chemical risk

assessments: Case studies addressing nanoscale considerations.

## Questions:

- The potential applicant is planning to send a proposal that will include several case studies in the diverse sublots in LOT2. Can you please clarify for us if these type of proposals will be granted in their entireness, or single case studies will be selected?
- The potential applicant thinking about including LOT1 in our proposal. Can LOT1 and LOT2 be part of the same proposal, or two separate applications should be sent, one for LOT1 and one for LOT2?
  - And in this case, should the two proposals be sent in two separate envelops, thus two separate postal shipping?
- Does the coordinator need to be the one who sends the application by post, or can another partner make the shipment of the envelope on behalf of the coordinator?
- Is it possible to provide with the word version of the OECD IATA template mentioned at pg. 15 of the call, foot note 21?

## **Answers:**

- As indicated in the call, for LOT2 the selection will be done in two phases and each case study will be assessed independently. Depending on the results single cases may be selected and granted. The selection process is explained in the call.
- EFSA recommends two separate applications, one per each lot. The beneficiary can send two separate applications in two separate envelopes, in one single postal shipping.





- The shipment can be done by a co-beneficiary on behalf of the coordinator.
