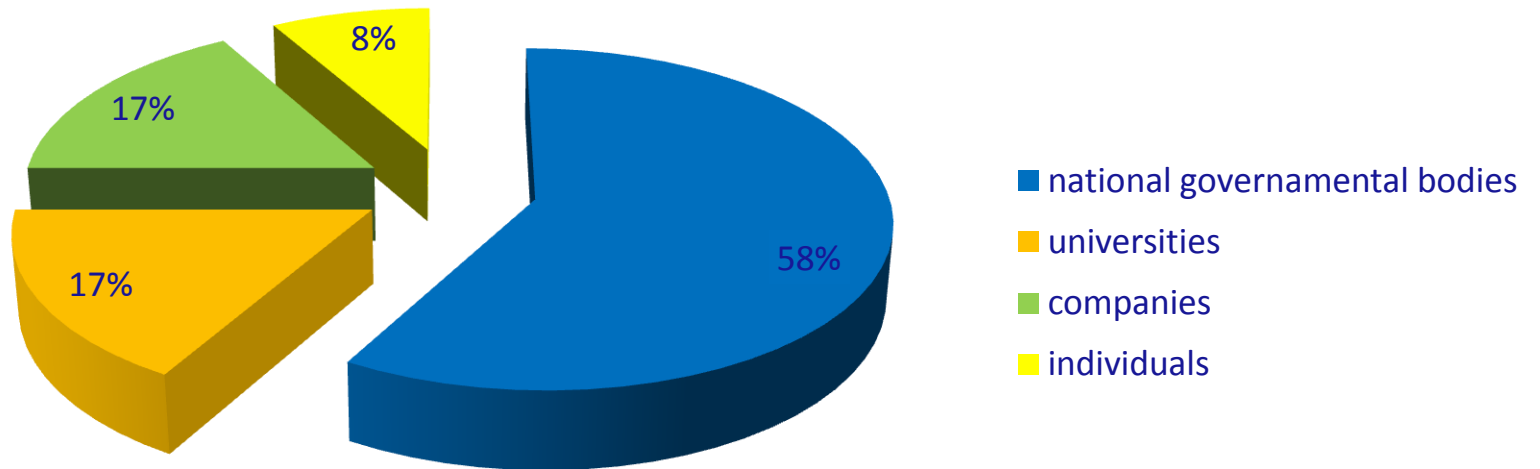
# Public consultation

  - EU (**11**) Switzerland (1)



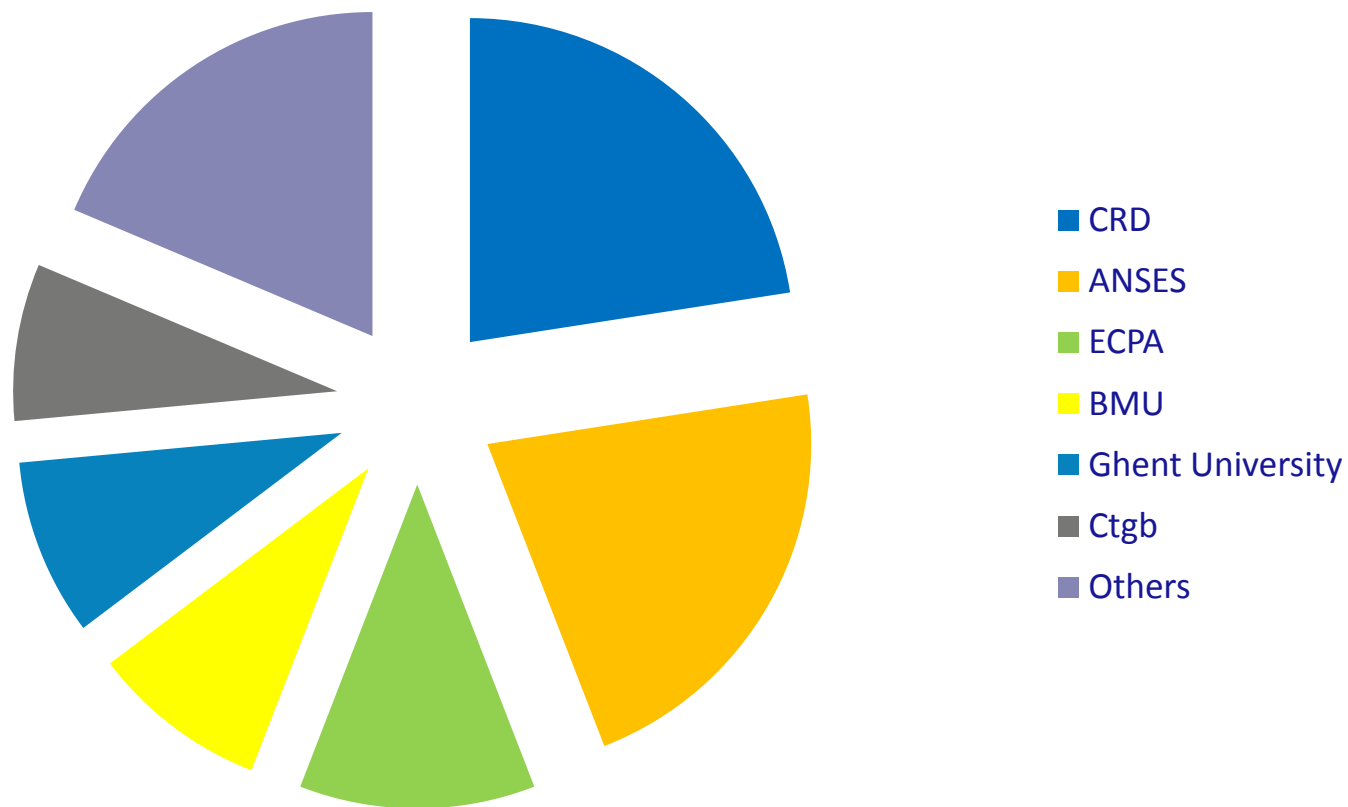


# Participants per category



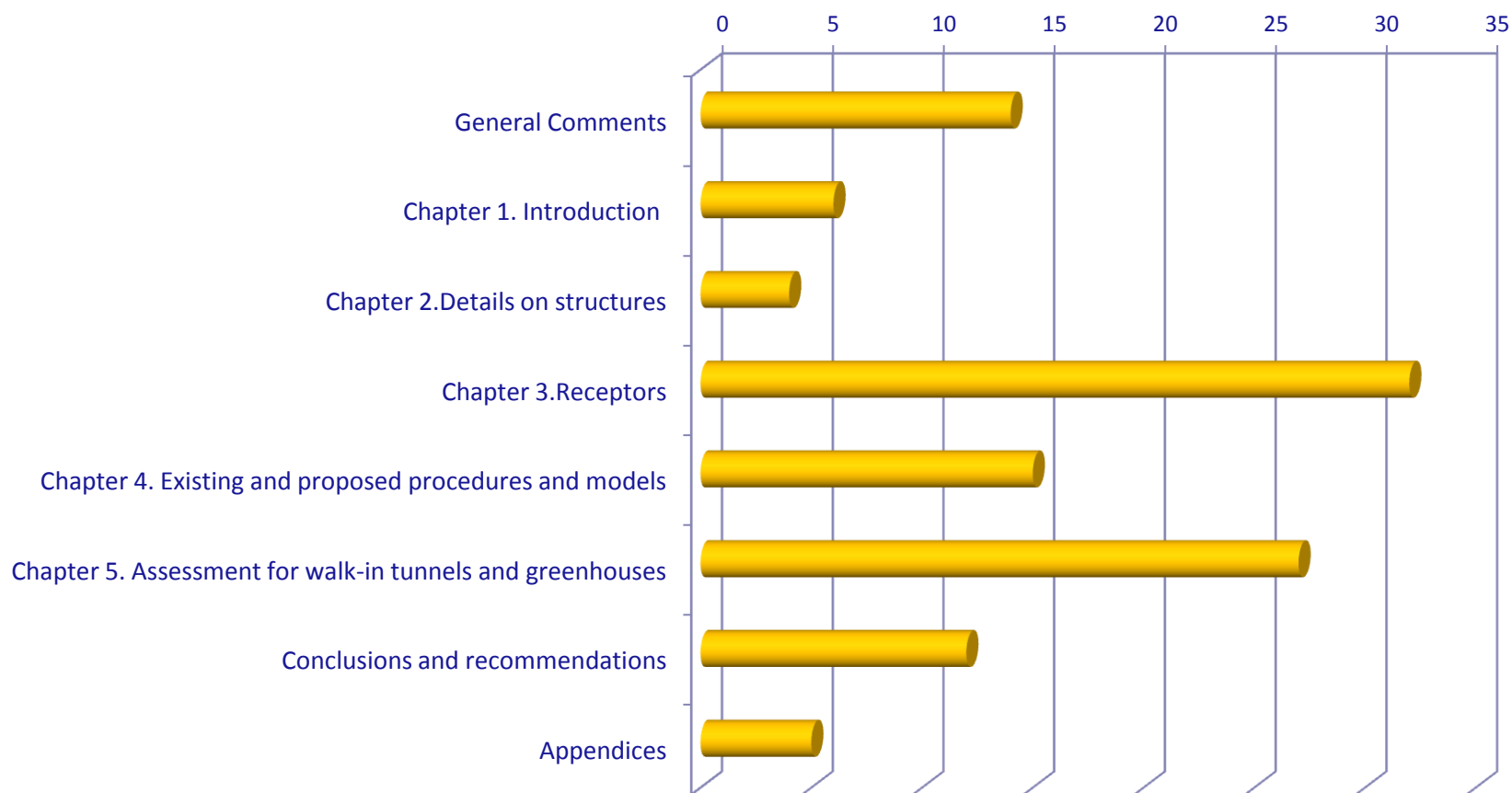


# Contributions per organisation

## General remarks

- Document is needed
- Important to have clearer definition and to know when open field scenarios can be used
- Rather complex
- Limited number of examples → difficult to find matching situation
- High diversity in systems within Europe and high impact of climatological conditions



# Consequences of Open field as first Tier approach to basic structures??

- What about mitigation measures ?
  - Can structure not be considered as mitigation measure
  - Should the same measures be taken
  
- Conservatism not always clear
  - higher temperature might accelerate degradation
  - precipitation might be lower



## Other possible important exposures routes not discussed

- volatile compound from closed building
- leaching through fingered flow associated to drip irrigation



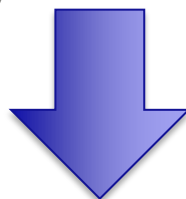
- Altered (non uniform) irrigation pattern





## Several 'waste streams'

- Possibly contaminated materials not to be considered under pesticides legislation
  - Growing substrates (eg compost)
  - Deteriorated cycle water



- To be treated under **national 'waste related' laws**

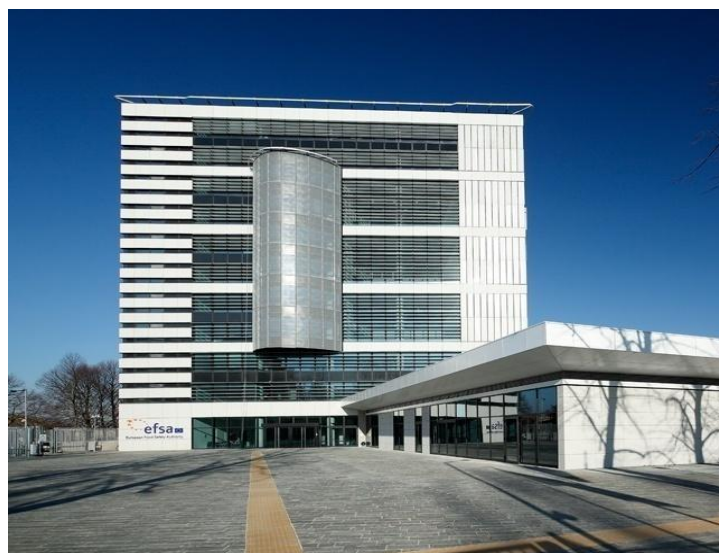
