3 AREAS WHERE EFSA IS DOING WELL

- 1) EFSA is Proactive and Continously improving
 - (access and quality)
 - being one of the institutions making most efforts in transparency, i.e. webstreaming
 - Model for countries outside EU (wider than transparency)
- 2) EFSA is listening and prepared to be challenged
- 3) **EFSA** is opening better channels for feedback



3 AREAS WHERE EFSA SHOULD BE DOING BETTER

1) Improve the Transparency of the Risk Assessment process

- WG minutes more information, faster, easy to follow the discussions
- More independent risk research if/how?
- Accessibility of data from Member states
- Accessibility of data on the website
- Transparency on Confidentiality process and outcome
- Risk assessment process: explanation on data used/not used



3 AREAS WHERE EFSA SHOULD BE DOING BETTER

2) Increase Consultation earlier and at different stages of the Process

- Pre submission meetings/groups of applicants
- Catalogue of Services for Applicants
- Concerns about preversation of Independence
- More engagement of SHs in scientific meetings
- SHF/SHForum/ Bureau to have the possibility to ask scientific questions for "self tasking"



3 AREAS WHERE EFSA SHOULD BE DOING BETTER

3) Improve the Clarity and Accessibility of the Website

- Explaining decision-making e.g. Infographics
- Transparency on process and decision
- More advocacy for science
- Methods in line with international scientific principles (difference of opinion)
- Update policy on transparency/info to public
