### STAKEHOLDER BUREAU - FRAMEWORK FOR INTERACTION

- The Bureau shall be composed of one representative from each of the seven stakeholder categories
- Members of the Bureau shall act in the interests of the stakeholder category that they represent rather than solely in the interests of their organisation
- The Bureau shall meet in person at least once a year
- The Bureau shall be chaired by EFSA's Executive Director and the chair of the MB will be invited to the annual meeting



#### STAKEHOLDER BUREAU – OBJECTIVES

- To contribute to the preparation of the annual Stakeholder Forum and monitor the actions EFSA takes as a result of the Forum
- To advise EFSA on stakeholder engagement and provide its views on whether EFSA is engaging with stakeholders in a balanced way
- To provide input to EFSA at a high level with regards to societal concerns on health, environment, food production and other issues in the Authority's remit

- Input received today will be considered in an updated version to be circulated for a second round of consultation
- Final document will be submitted to the Bureau at its first meeting in Q4 2017
