<b>15/11/17</b>	AMU	<b>Launch of 1st EFSA challenge: Visualisation of Uncertainty in Geospatial Data</b>	After a pilot project on crowdsourcing in 2016-7 EFSA is launching two challenges to identify potential new uses of scientific tools in risk assessment.
