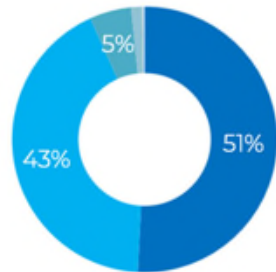

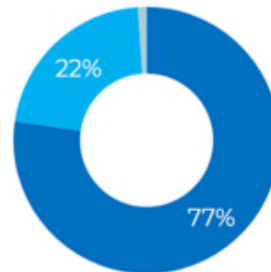

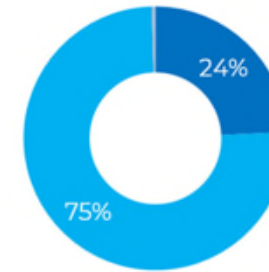

The length of the conference was...

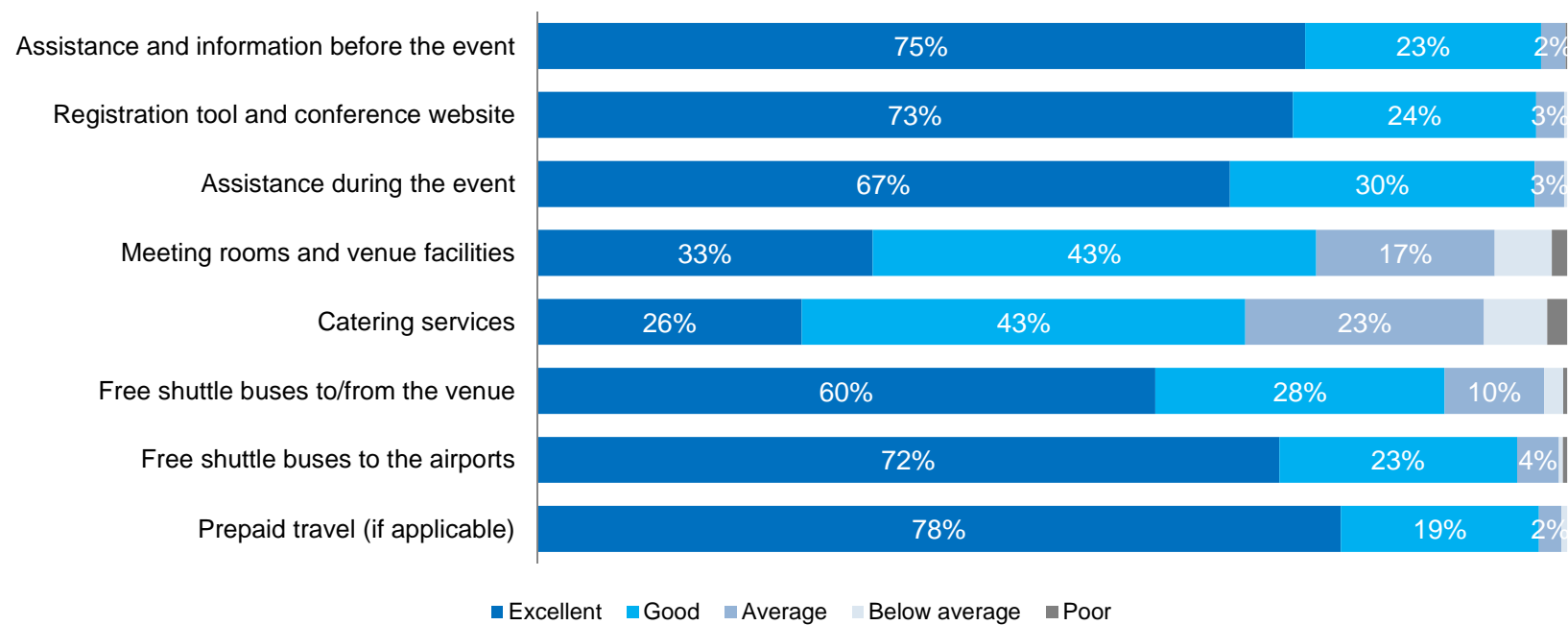

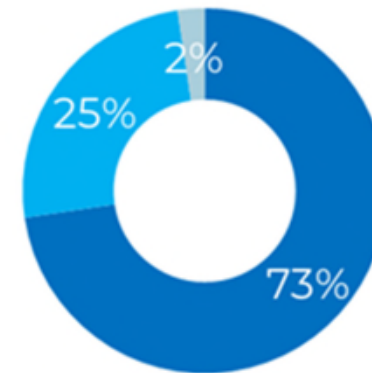
