
 Support novel food applicants in submitting their dossiers.

- Liaison with international partners (e.g., WHO, FAO, OECD).




ENGAGING WITH STAKEHOLDERS: THE FARM TO FORK ANIMAL WELFARE MANDATES (SINCE 2023)
